


ANTI-SEXUAL HARASSMENT CELL

Following the guidelines by Regulation 14(1) of the Gender Sensitization & Sexual Harassment of Women at the Supreme Court of India (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Regulations 2013, an Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell was set up in Pavanatma College in order to sensitize students on the issues of gender justice and to take action against any reported act of sexual harassment.

As per the UGC regulations on curbing the menace of gender inequalities in colleges, an anti sexual harassment committee for the year 2020-2021 was constituted under the chairmanship of the principal. The other members of the committee comprises the vice principal, four faculty members, Sub Inspector of Police, president of PTA, office superintendent, hostel warden and four student representatives. The first meeting of the committee was convened via online mode, in the presence of all members of the committee on 10th June 2020. Principal asserted the importance of having a strong anti-sexual harassment committee and inspired all the members to create a virtuous environment in the campus. The members proactively gave their suggestions for the successful functioning of the committee. In the meeting the members decided to create posters to promote anti-sexual harassment and to spread awareness. Also took special care to create awareness among the students through online platforms.

Under the guidance of the committee, teachers and class representatives went for inspections in the campus during breaks in the months of January, February and March to keep the ragging in check and also to ensure that the awareness created by the committee among class representatives, teachers and students are sustaining. A session was also conducted for the first year students along with the orientation program to make them aware of their rights, why gender based harassment is a criminal offence and where to report in case of any incidence.

The initiatives of the anti-sexual harassment committee were a huge success. No incidents of sexual abuses were reported in the academic year 2020-21.

COUNSELING CELL

Outreach cell conducted various programmes in this academic year (2020-2021) with the coordination of various cells, clubs and departments. The following were the programmes:


1. A seminar on the topic place of supply under GST
