

Based on the analysis of feedback, it is found that most of the students are satisfied with the course content, its implementation and evaluation process. Improvement is needed for effectiveness of online class.


How much of the syllabus was covered in the class




How well did the teachers prepare for the classes




How well were the teachers able to communicate?




The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as




Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.


































Depth of the course content




Extent of coverage
